



## **(U-CAN) United College Action Network**

*Historically Black College Recruitment Fair*

The United College Action Network (U-CAN) founded in 1988 by Dr. Alan and Donna Rowe is a California 501©(3) Nonprofit corporation that provides leadership services and assistance to students desiring to enroll in four-year Historically Black Colleges and Universities. Since 1988, U-CAN has provided services to more than **56,000** students. More than **15,000** of these students subsequently gained admission to a Historically Black College or University (HBCU). U-CAN has generated over **\$55,000,000** in scholarship monies for students who received U-CAN services. U-CAN's demonstrated track record has created successful educational support; outreach mentoring services and programs nationwide.

U-CAN maintains a credible and intimate relationship with local school districts as well as university and college presidents, admissions officers, financial aid and administrative officers, which has been a significant factor in assisting students to gain admissions and scholarships to HBCUs. U-CAN provides information and/or assistance to various school districts in California and Nationwide.

### **STUDENT CHECKLIST~What to bring with you to the college fair**

**SENIORS** are encouraged to bring the following items to the College Fair to ensure they receive **"ON-THE-SPOT"** admissions and scholarship consideration:

- Copies of transcript, if available for each college application you plan to complete (See flyer for list of attending colleges)
- A copy of your SAT/ACT score (if taken) for each college application you plan to complete
- Letter(s) of recommendation (at least 2 if available, addressed~ To whom it may concern )
- Personal Essay (if available)

**Reminder: Some of the colleges accept students who have a minimum 2.0 GPA and haven't taken the SAT/ACT**

**JUNIORS and OTHERS** should bring the following:

- An unofficial transcript for colleges to review
- 10 to 12 labels with your name, address, school, grade, current GPA and intended major to be given to each college you want to send you additional information

**Transfer students** should bring the following:

- An unofficial transcript for colleges to review

### **ALL STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE :**

- Information regarding each of the colleges represented at the college fair
- Application fee waivers for many of the colleges represented
- ACT/SAT information and Financial aid information
